

Vasily Sukhomlinsky (1918-1970) was the principal of a combined primary and secondary school in the Ukrainian village of Pavlysh. Together with his dedicated staff, he created a holistic system of education that was deeply embedded in the natural environment and fostered the qualities of curiosity, empathy and creativity. Every child's inherent abilities were nurtured and developed. Children were trained to be responsible custodians of the natural environment, and informed and active members of society.

Students enrolling in Sukhomlinsky's school became part of a vibrant learning community in which teachers, parents, community members, and the students themselves all played a role in educating each other. Dozens of clubs and activity groups operated after school, most attended by children of varying ages, and the older children played a significant role in educating younger children. In this environment students became autonomous, lifelong learners.
